Your letter should be between 150 – 200 words long. Do not write an address.


You will receive up to 8 marks for the content of your letter and up to 7 marks for the style and accuracy of your language.

Exercise 2


Both parents and students are greatly concerned about the amount of time spent at school.

You are a student, write a newspaper article expressing your views concerning this issue.


The comments below may give you some ideas but you are free to use any ideas of your own.




Schooling is no more fun, there is just too much time spent at school now.
