Respondents with unknown Perception of Risk data were excluded.² Respondents with unknown Perceived Availability data were excluded.³ Response categories for the Perceived Availability questions pertaining to the listed illicit drugs include "Probably impossible," "Very difficult," "Fairly difficult," "Fairly easy," and "Very easy." The estimates in this table correspond to individuals reporting "Fairly easy" or "Very easy."
