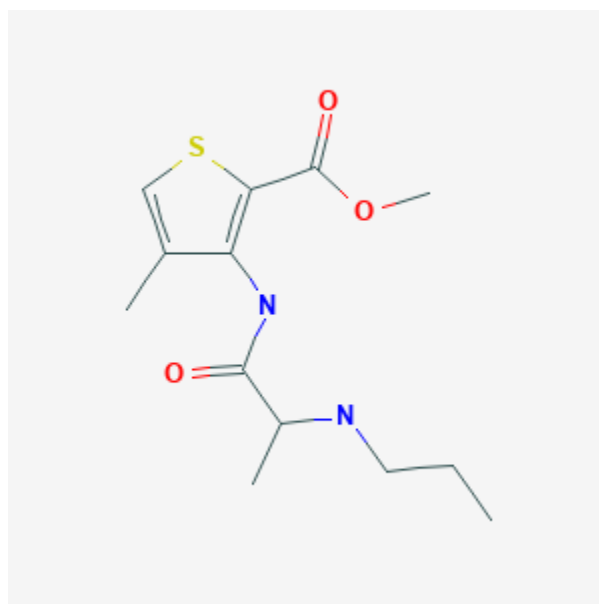

Drug Levels and Effects

Summary of Use during Lactation

No information is available on the use of articaïne during breastfeeding. Based on the low excretion of other local anesthetics into breastmilk, a single dose of articaïne injected during breastfeeding is unlikely to adversely affect the breastfed infant. However, an alternate drug may be preferred, especially while nursing a newborn or preterm infant.
