The Dipartimento Scientifico e Tecnologico of the University of Verona organizes the International Conference on Digital Audio Effects, DAFx-00, in Verona, Italy, 7-9 December, 2000. The Conference is sponsored by the Action-G6 “Digital Audio Effects” of the European COST program, and supported by the University of Verona, the Conservatory of Verona and by AIMI (Ass. Informatica Musicale Italiana).

DAFx-00 is an international meeting of researchers in theoretical and applied digital sound and music signal processing including topics like:

- Filtering and Modulation;
- Delay;
- Time and Frequency Scaling;
- Spatialisation;
- Spectral Processing;
- Audio Coding;
- Software and Hardware Implementation;
- Sound Modeling;
- Perceptual Issues.

DAFx-00 will present sound models, examples, software and hardware applications of interest to musicians, computer scientists, engineers and other.

Abstract submission

We invite submissions of papers in all aspects of digital audio effects as mentioned above. There are two formats for presentation:

- Oral presentation of paper:
Maximum 6 pages in the Proceedings; about 20 minutes for presentation.
- Poster presentation:
Maximum 4 pages in the Proceedings.

The following items should be included in the submission:

- Author names and electronic contact information, corresponding author first.
- Contact information for corresponding author: Address, e-mail, phone, fax.
- Preferable submission type. Choose one of: Paper, Tutorial or Poster.
- Title of paper.
- Keywords and content area.
- Resources for presentation (CD, DAT, video, etc.)

The official language is English. All submissions are subject to peer review. The accepted contributions will be published in the Conference Proceedings.
